

The Place value Apartments





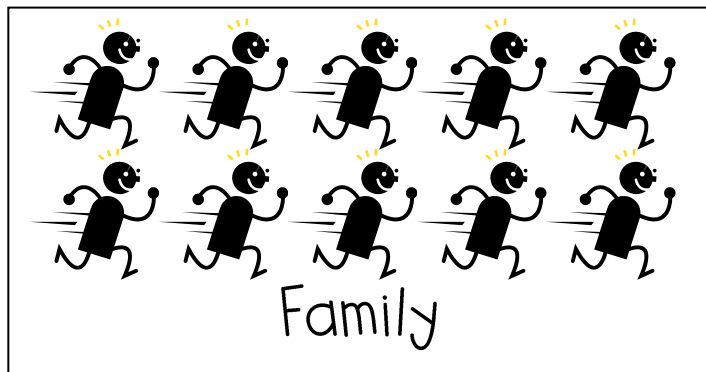
Once there was a man who moved into the Ones House. The landlord told him, "Only nine people can live in this house."



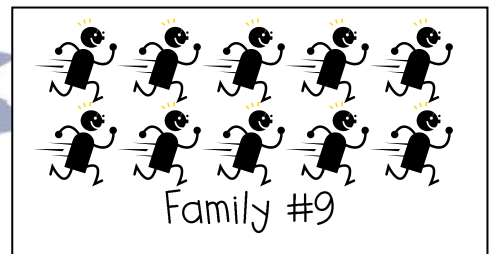
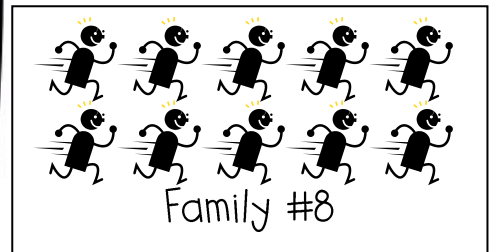
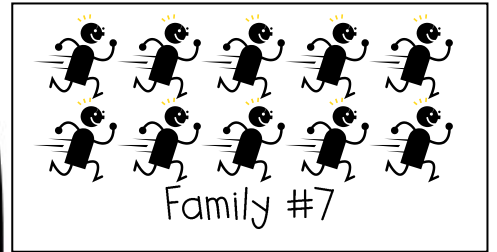
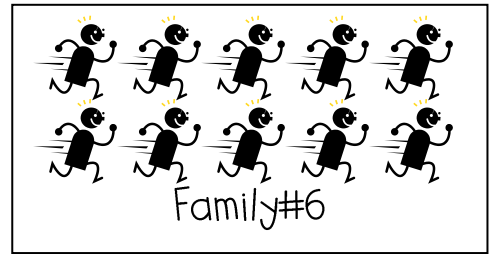
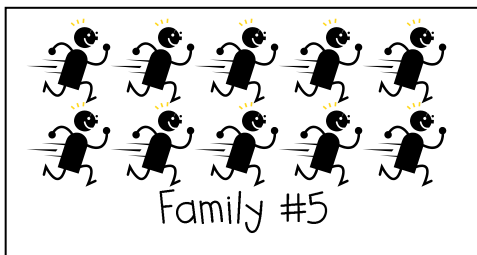
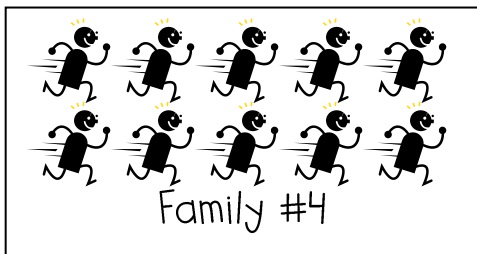
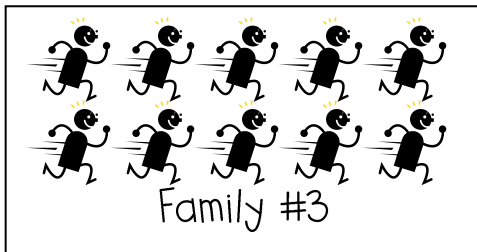
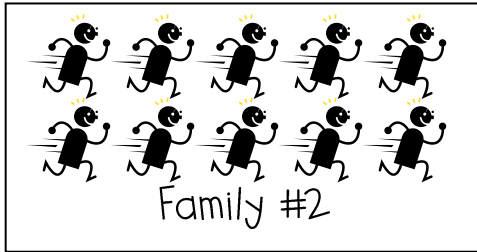
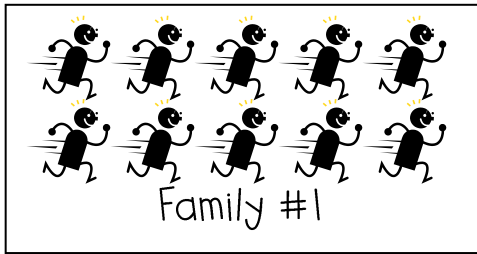
Over time more and more people moved into the Ones House.



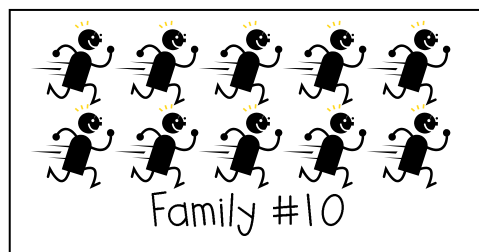
When the 10th person moved in, the landlord told them they would all have to move.













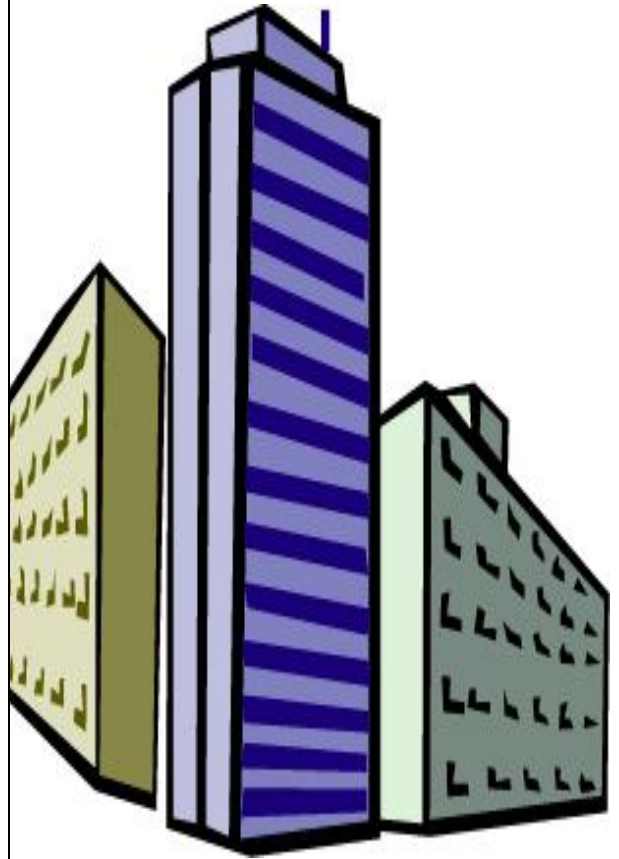
So they became one family of 10 people and moved into the Tens Apartment Building. This Tens Apartment Building had enough space for 9 families just like theirs, with 10 people in each family.
